I acknowledge receipt of the letter dated October 10, 2014 from the Ministry Finance and Planning providing considered comments from the Government and Information and Communication Technology Agency (ICTA) on the draft Implementation Completion and Results Report (ICRR). We appreciate the detailed comments provide and thank you for acknowledging the team's efforts in preparing this report as well as a Bank's role during the implementation of this project.

As you are aware the ICRR process is an independent one and in line with approach/methodology for such assessments, we have now finalized the report. In doing we carefully considered the comments that were received from Government and ICTA a have reflected changes where factual information received warranted modifications. We the additional information on the outcomes achieved by the project, despite the deficience in the Project Development Objective (PDO) statement which posed challenges attributing some of the project's effects, we are happy to convey that the Development Outcome rating has been upgraded to Satisfactory. In addition, in line with our practices such completion reports, your key comments have been summarized in the main text of ticre.

On the matter of the assessment of ICTA, we again carefully reviewed to comments that have been made. We agree, and the ICRR notes, that ICTA has developed into a capable and professional institution, and has played a substantive role in the significant outcomes that the project has attained. However, on the rating, in line with the guidance received from the detailed internal review process that we underwent a considering the overall project period, the variations in implementation progress performance at different points in time, and other factors including the non-compliance the signing of Subsidiary Grant Agreement, the assessment will remain as Moderate Satisfactory. This rating recognizes the essential role of ICTA as the implementing agency but there were moderate shortcomings in implementation and hence the Moderate Satisfactory rating remains. In line with our terminology the correct interpretation of the rating connotes successful performance by the implementing entity.

We have also reviewed carefully your other points and have sought to factor the into the report, where appropriate.

Please find attached the ICRR in its final form for its imminent publication.
