Under the Sri Lanka Accounting and Auditing Standards Act No. 15 of 1995, all quoted companies, banking, finance, insurance, and leasing companies, other large companies (Public and Private) and Public Corporations are required to comply with Sri Lanka Accounting Standards. Under the Act, Sri Lanka Accounting and Auditing Standards Monitoring Board (SLAASMB) is empowered to call for documents, information and explanations from Directors and Managers of Specified Business Enterprises (SBEs) and Auditors of Specified Business Enterprises (SBEs) for the purpose of carrying out monitoring activities to ensure the annual audited financial statements, submitted by the above mentioned organizations comply with the required standards.

The current system at SLAASMB is to record and maintain information on receipts, reviews and analysis of financial statements and reviews of audit files that are based on a number of access/excel worksheets which causes limitations and errors when carrying out the day to day work of the organization.

With the aim of improving efficiency and effectiveness of the process, Information and Communication Technology Agency of Sri Lanka (ICTA) in collaboration with stakeholder institutions is in the process of implementing Management Information System (MIS) for Sri Lanka Accounting and Auditing Standards Monitoring Board. This initiative has also been identified as a priority project of the national digital development strategy implemented by ICTA from 2016.

In order to define in detail, the system requirements, related specifications, conduct system information classification, system prototype and the implementation approach, ICTA intends to obtain the service of a consultant (individual) to carry out a requirement study.
