Development of e-Services Web applications for Government Organizations

Information and Communication Technology Agency of Sri Lanka (ICTA) functions under the purview of Ministry of Telecommunication and Digital Infrastructure is the apex government agency for Information and Communication Technology (ICT) in Sri Lanka which has been mandated to take all necessary measures to implement the Government's Policy and Action Plan in relation to ICT.

ICTA has embarked on a series of ICT Development initiatives for the implementation of Digital Infrastructure solutions and other projects across multiple sectors. With these planned initiatives, ICTA, in collaboration with key government organizations is continuing to assist government organizations for developing Electronic Services (eServices) to serve their stakeholders in more efficient and effective manner.

Currently there is a requirement for development of eServices Government organizations and ICTA intends initiating this project in two rapid development phases in order to have development past tracked and implement the services as a priority project. Therefore ICTA intends to proceed with the selection process of firms to develop eServices.

ICTA now invites Expressions of Interest (EOIs) from eligible firms that are willing to take up these two assignments listed in Table below;

Interested Firms depending on their qualifications, experience and capacity may submit their EOIs for one of the assignments. One firm shall only be short listed only for one of the assignments.

EOI must include requested information as specified in the "EOI Information Form" along with documentary evidence in support of core business and years in business, Financial, Business and Administrative strength/standing, qualifications in the field of assignment, experience in carrying out assignments of a similar nature and complexity, technical and managerial organization of the firm, technical capabilities and appropriate skills of key staff of the organization and other relevant information.
