**Procurement of Sinhala and Tamil Unicode Fonts  
ICTA/GOSL/GOODS/NS/2016/35(A)**

The Information and Communication Technology Agency of Sri Lanka (ICTA), which functions under the purview of the Ministry of Telecommunication and Digital Infrastructure, has been addressing issues relating to enabling ICT in local languages.

ICTA intends to procure several Sinhala and Tamil working Unicode fonts (with font rules), to ensure the availability of more local language Unicode fonts.

- The Sinhala fonts should be accurate with correct strokes for all characters in commonly used point sizes. All Sinhala consonants and vowels and all combinations of consonants with vowels should be included. The fonts should include the 12 conjunct letters and their combinations with strokes, and conform to Level 3 in the *Sri Lanka Standard Sinhala Character Code for Information Interchange SLS 1134 : 2004, Part 2, Requirements and Methods of Test*.
- The Tamil fonts should be in line with the *Sri Lanka Tamil Character Code for Information Interchange, SLS 1326 : 2008* and should be accurate for all characters with correct strokes in commonly used point sizes and include all Tamil vowels, consonants and Grantha letters. Tamil symbols in the Unicode standard should be included. The two glyphs for “Shri” should be included; ශ් and ு

The license should be such that it should allow ICTA to modify the fonts and also give it out free of charge to the country-at large under the license Creative Commons Attribution. The decision to procure the most suitable fonts shall be based on the review and recommendation of an expert panel.
