Information and Communication Technology Agency of Sri Lanka (ICTA) is the apex government agency for Information and Communication Technology (ICT) in Sri Lanka which has been mandated to take all necessary measures to implement the Government's Policy and Action Plan in relation to ICT.

ICTA has implemented series of ICT projects with the intention of providing government services to citizens, in a friendly and an efficient manner by re-engineering and technologically empowering the government organizations. ICTA launched the first Government Transactional eService in December, 2009 by introducing the Online Revenue License Renewal facility through the Sri Lanka Country Portal. Since then ICTA has developed more than 50 online services offered through approximately 23 government organizations covering different sectors.

Implementation of mobile applications to deliver selected government services that are with frequent demand from the citizens, is been identified as one of the most effective as well as the efficient ways of service delivery. In order to rapidly innovate and remain competitive in a mobile society, an organization must have a comprehensive mobile app that reaches its individual target segments.

Hence, ICTA intends to initiate new mobile application development project further to the ongoing developments, to implement more mobile applications, which will enable reliable accessibility to the government information and services, by the citizens.

ICTA now invites Expressions of Interest (EOIs) from eligible consulting firms that are willing to develop mobile applications for existing and new e-services. EOI must include requested information as specified in the "EOI Information Form" along with documentary evidence in support of core business and years in business, Financial, Business and Administrative strength/standing, qualifications in the field of assignment, experience in carrying out assignments of a similar nature and complexity, technical and managerial organization of the firm, technical capabilities and appropriate skills of key staff of the organization and other relevant information.

Consulting firms will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the Government Guidelines: Selection & Employment of Consultants; following Quality and Cost Based
