Individual Consultant –Implementation support and maintenance of Integrated Library Management System (ILMS) - (Part time)

Contract No: ICTA/GOSL/CON/IC/2020/01A

Background

The Information and Communication Technology Agency (ICTA) of Sri Lanka is the apex ICT institution of the Government. In terms of the Information and Communication Technology Act No.27 of 2003 (ICT Act), ICTA has been mandated to take all necessary measures to implement the Government's Policy and Action Plan in relation to ICT.

ICT Agency of Sri Lanka implements the Digital Libraries Project in close collaboration with National Library and Documentation Services Board to introduce modern digital infrastructure and library automation at public libraries in Sri Lanka which is in demand to improve the quality and efficiency of the library system in the country. This project aims to establish 26 Model Digital Public libraries one in each district and at National Library of Sri Lanka. The scope of this project comprises providing computers, tablet devices, a network facility, and an integrated library management system ("Koha", an Open Source Integrated Library Management System) to the selected libraries. This project has established digital libraries at 08 libraries namely Colombo, Batticaloa, Kurunegala, Polonnaruwa, Badulla, Kirimetiya, and Opanayake and at National Library. The project is planned to be implemented in the remaining eighteen (18) districts in order to strengthen the public library network across the country.

ICTA is looking for an experienced Consultant to introduce the Integrated Library Management System (ILMS) and Model Digital Library concept to the selected 18 public libraries during the project period. The role involves identifying ILMS requirements, introducing *Koha*-ILMS to selected 18 public libraries, conduct change management, conducting training and capacity building on ILMS of the selected library staff. The consultant will work closely with National Library and Documentation Services Board, library administrators and the library staff to promote and implement digital library initiatives in order to improve the quality and efficiency of access and the usage of digital information.

1. Scope of Work

Under the overall supervision of the Programme Head of ICT Agency of Sri Lanka, the Individual Consultant will be responsible for implementation of "*Koha*" ILMS and introducing model Digital Library concept at selected 18 public libraries. The consultant is responsible to carryout support and maintenance activities at all 26 libraries including the digital libraries established in 2019 under the project.

Selected Consultant should guarantee that ICTA achieve the project outputs, outcomes and impact by implementing the project activities in accordance with ICTA rules, regulations and guidance of the ICTA Library management team

Key Activities

The consultant should be responsible to provide following key activities at selected 26 libraries under Digital Libraries Project.

- I. Study project documents and be familiar with the Project and Project outputs, Outcomes and impact.
- II. Situation Assessment: Study the current status of the library management process and identify existing process gaps.
- III. Plan, design and implement unique change management process for each library.
- IV. Implementation of “Koha” ILMS (Installation, customization, Configuration etc.) facilitate the process improvement in order to enhance the service quality and effectiveness.
- V. Identify the training & capacity gaps of the users of ILMS, plan, design and conduct training and capacity development programmes in order to enhance the capacity in terms of knowledge, usage of the ILM system and increase the self-motivation of ILMS users. Design and Conduct training and capacity development evaluations
- VI. Participate in all Library management project meetings convened by the ICTA,
- VII. Visit selected libraries and work closely with all project stakeholders.
- VIII. Monitoring the implementation process regularly and prepare quarterly progress reports.
- IX. Introduce and maintain a backup solution of Koha ILMS at each public library
- X. Prepare an ILM System operation manual.
- XI. Train and strengthen the capacity of a person or /group of persons nominated by ICTA on the ILMS operations
