Detailed description of the Requirements and Specifications are given in the bidding document.

- 1. Bidding will be conducted using the **National Competitive Bidding (NCB) method that shall be governed by the procurement guidelines of Government of Sri Lanka** and is open to all eligible bidders that meet the eligibility and qualification requirements given in the bidding documents.
- 2. Interested bidders may **inspect the bidding documents** free of charge through ICTA Website (https://www.icta.lk/procurement/) only for inspection purposes.
- 3. A complete set of Bidding Documents in English Language may be purchased by interested bidders on submission of a written application and upon payment(in cash at the ICTA office or deposit to ICTA bank account) of a non-refundable fee of Sri Lankan Rupees Three Thousand Five Hundred (**LKR.3**, **500.00**) effective from 10th June 2021 during office hours on working days . Bidders who need bank detail should send a request to procurement@icta.lk.
- 4. A online Pre-bid meeting will be held at 11.00 a.m on 16th June 2021. Meeting link will be published in the ICTA website from 3.00 p.m on 15th June 2021. The potential bidders are advised to attend this meeting.
- 5. Bids must be delivered to Procurement Division, Information and Communication Technology Agency of Sri Lanka (ICTA), 160/24, 2nd Floor, Kirimandala Mawatha, Colombo 05 at or before 1500 hrs (3.00 p.m) on 24th June 2021. Bids will be opened immediately after the deadline of bid submission in the presence of the bidders' representatives, who choose to attend. Late Bids and Bids sent electronically will not be accepted and will be rejected.
- 6. All Bids must be accompanied by Bid Security in the form of a Bank Guarantee of Rs.160,000 from a Bank registered with Sri Lanka Central Bank using the format given with the bidding documents.

- 8. Bids shall be valid for a period of 91 days from the date of deadline for submission of the bids.
- 10. ICTA will not be responsible for any costs or any expenses incurred by the Bidders in connection with the preparation or delivery of Bids.

		General	
1.	Scope of Bid	.1 The Purchaser indicated in the Bidding Data Sheet (BDS) , issues these Bidding Documents for the supply of Goods and Related Services incidental thereto as specified in Section V, Schedule of Requirements. The name and identification number of this National Competitive Bidding (NCB) procurement are specified in the BDS . The name, identification, and number of item,, if any, are provided in the BDS .	
		.2 Throughout these Bidding Documents:	
		(a) The term "in writing" means communicated in written form by mail, e-mail or hand delivered with proof of receipt;	
		(b) If the context so requires, "singular" means "plural" and vice versa; and	
		(c) "Day" means calendar day.	
2.	Source of Funds	2.1 Payments under this contract will be financed by the source specified in the BDS.	
3.	Ethics, Fraud and Corruption	 5.1 The attention of the bidders is drawn to the following guidelines of the Procurement Guidelines published by National Procurement Agency: Parties associated with Procurement Actions, namely, suppliers/contractors and officials shall ensure that they maintain strict confidentiality throughout the process; Officials shall refrain from receiving any personal gain from any Procurement Action. No gifts or inducement shall be accepted. Suppliers/contractors are liable to be disqualified from the bidding process if found offering any gift or inducement which may have an effect of influencing a decision or impairing the objectivity of an official. 5.2 The Purchaser requires the bidders, suppliers, contractors, and consultants to observe the highest standard of ethics 	
		 during the procurement and execution of such contracts. In pursuit of this policy: (a) "corrupt practice" means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting, directly or indirectly, of anything of value to influence the action of a public official in the procurement process or in contract execution;

All bidders found to have conflict of interest shall be disqualified. Bidders may be considered to have a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process, if they: (a) are or have been associated in the past, with a firm or any of its affiliates which have been engaged by the Purchaser to provide consulting services for the preparation of the design, specifications, and other documents to be used for the procurement of the goods to be purchased under these Bidding Documents; or (b) submit more than one bid in this bidding process. However, this does not limit the participation of subcontractors in more than one bid. 4.3 A Bidder that is under a declaration of ineligibility by the Government of Sri Lanka (GOSL), at the date of submission of bids or at the date of contract award, shall be disqualified.







Network Diagram of Veyangoda public library. Veyangoda-Gampaha District




Network Diagram of Doluwa public library, Doluwa - Kandy District



Network Diagram of Diyathilake public library, Hanguranketha - Nuwara Eliya District






Ruwanwella Public Library – Avissawella Network Diagram (Ground Floor)






Network Diagram of Nochchiyagama public library, Nochchiyagama- Anuradhapura District







Network Diagram of Ambalangoda public library, Ambalangoda- Galle District







Network Diagram of Hakmana public library, Hakmana-Matara District






Hambantota Public Library – Hambantota - Network Diagram (First Floor)










Network Diagram of Mannar public library, Mannar-Mannar District






Puthukudiyiruppu Public Library - Mulativu Network Diagram (Ground Floor)
